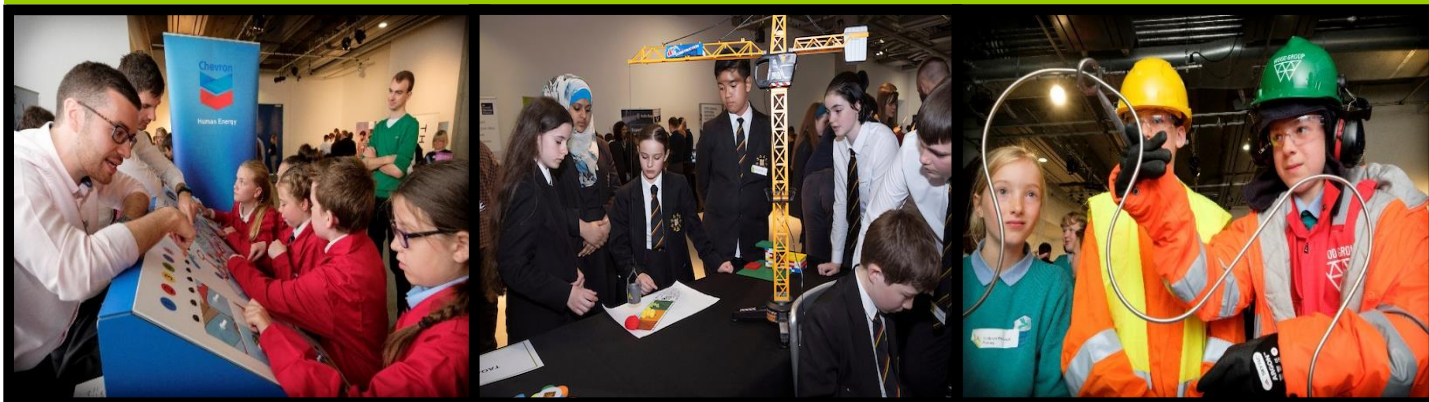




Regional Celebrations of STEM 2020

STEM CHALLENGE GUIDELINES

You are asked to set up and run a three-minute challenge which should focus on a particular engineering or scientific discipline related to your company. The age range of participants will be from 10-17 years, but as the majority of participants will be in the 11-15 age bands, challenges should be pitched accordingly, we'd be delighted to advise.

If company "giveaways" are provided, you are asked to bring sufficient for all team members attending your challenge. (circa 45).

TIMINGS OF CHALLENGES

Briefing each team of students: 2 minutes by company representatives.

The Challenge: 3 minutes one team member does the Challenge guided verbally by other team members.

Debriefing & Resetting the Challenge: 4 minutes by company representatives.

Teams will be marked on problem-solving, team working and overall achievement.

Prizes will be awarded to the best primary and best secondary team performance.

EQUIPMENT SUPPLIED

You will be provided with a trestle table and two chairs, a power supply will be available if required. A Wi-Fi password will be provided on the day. Please bring a small pop-up banner stand as a backdrop for your challenge.
